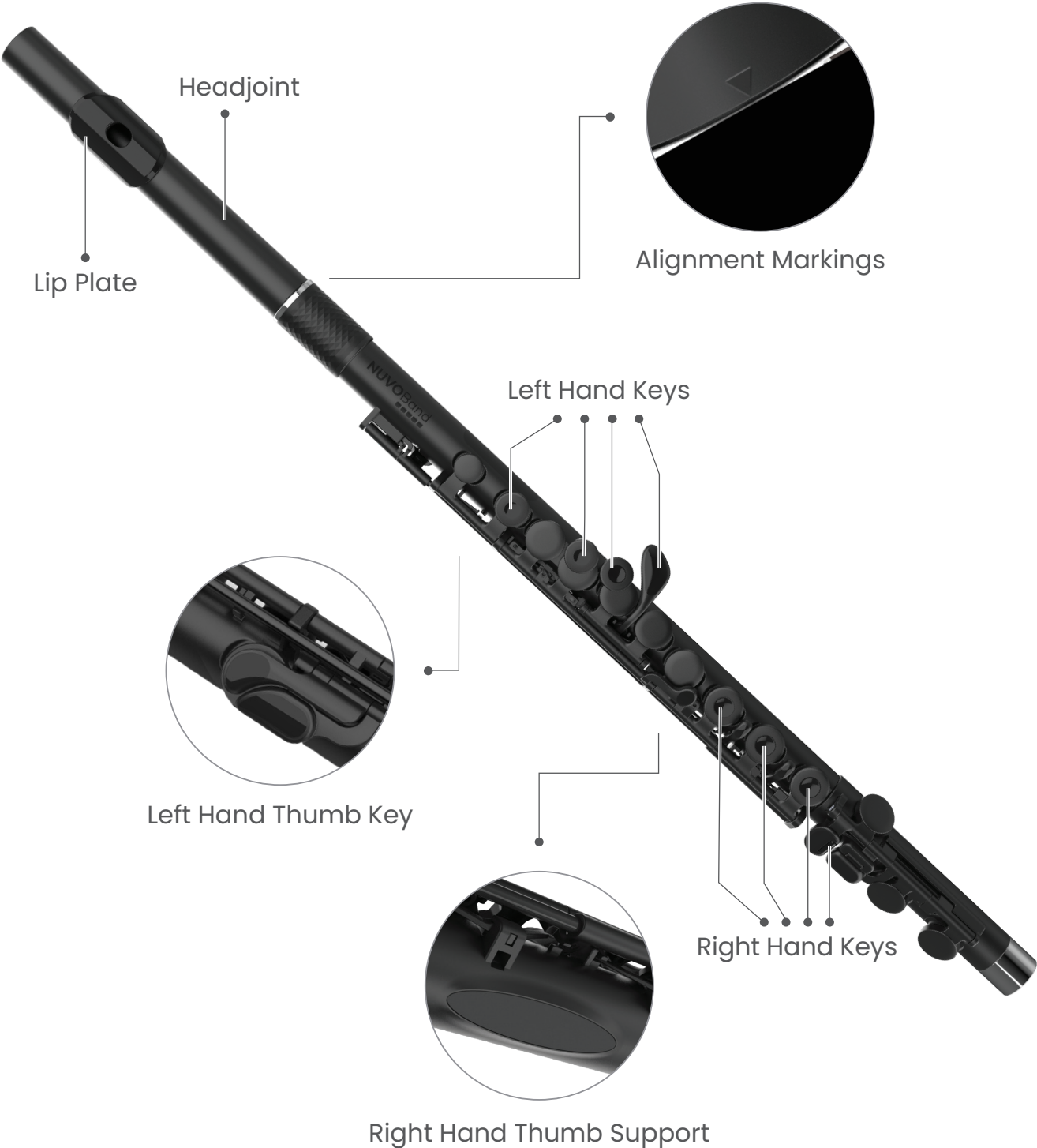

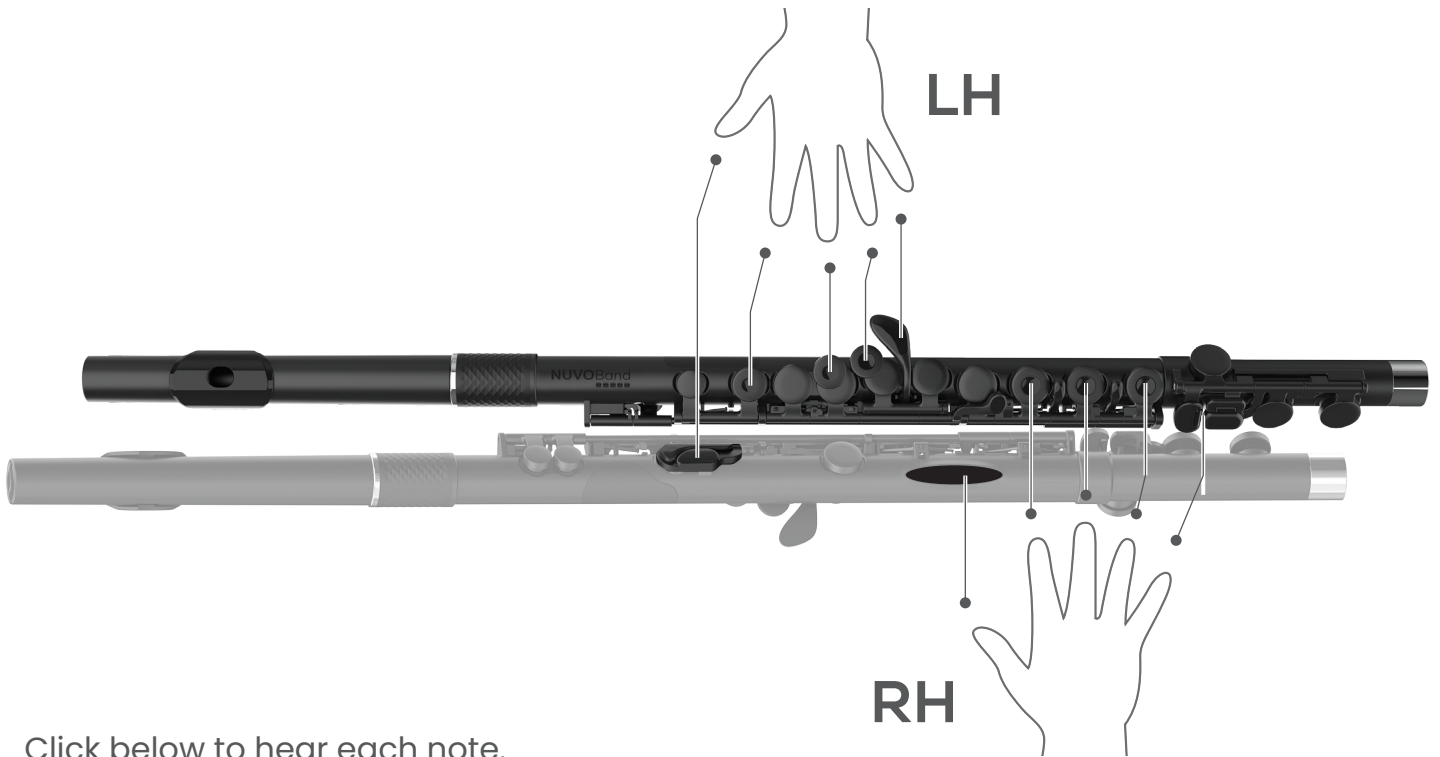


Let's Read Some Notes: C and D

NOTE C 




NOTE D




Multi-measure rest:

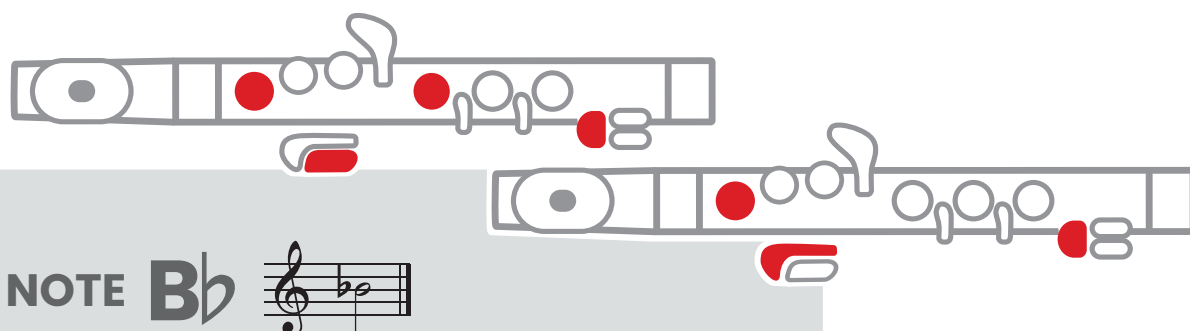
